You may be a person who qualifies for Diplomat Membership in an elite organization in Texas designed to honor the top 5% of genealogists in the state. The Texas Genealogical Council is being established to assist Texas genealogical, lineage, heraldry and heritage organizations communicate with one another and to plan cooperative ventures. We plan to create a comprehensive master calendar of genealogical , lineage, heritage and heraldry meetings and events in the state. Only the activities of member organizations will included in the map. Although this master calendar will not prevent conflicts, it will go a long way in avoiding conflicts. One of our goals is to assist smaller groups join with similar groups to conduct joint meetings.
